Arkansas Public School Choice Act

The Pine Bluff School District welcomes parents who would like to enroll their children for the 2019-2020 academic year. The "Arkansas Public School Choice Act of 2015" allows parents of students residing outside the Pine Bluff School District to enroll their children in Pine Bluff School District Schools. Parents have until May I to apply for the right to enroll this fall under the Arkansas Public School Choice Act.

Transfers into the Pine Bluff School District shall be granted on a nondiscriminatory basis without regard to the race of the student. Students who have been accepted (into the Pine Bluff School District) and enrolled in previous years do not have to apply again. Approved transfers remain valid for as long as the student attends Pine Bluff School District schools.

Applications are available at the Pine Bluff School District Administrative Center at 512 South Pine Street, Pine Bluff. The completed application must be delivered or postmarked to the Superintendent no later than May 1, 2019 for your child(ren) to be able to enroll in August. Students are eligible to enroll in grade appropriate schools.
